Getting to Know Your Phone





AT&T Mobile Music

AT&T Mobile Music provides the ultimate music experience. Listen to your favorite music, watch the latest music videos, and stay in the know with music news and more.

- From standby mode and with the slide closed, press the Left Soft Key for Menu and then select AT&T Music (1).
- Listen to your music with the integrated **Music Player**. Access your music by artist, album, genre, or playlist.
- Personalize your phone with music ringtones and Answer Tones™ at **Shop Music**.
- Instantly find out the artist's name and the title of a song with **MusicID**.
- Get unlimited access to commercial-free music and the latest hip-hop, R&B, rock, jazz, and country anywhere you go from **XM Radio**.
- Access music videos from the latest artists with **Music Videos**.
- Express yourself through custom ringtones with Make UR Tones.
- Visit one or more hot user communities by going to **Community**. Interact with friends and the community as well as review artist fan sites.
- Purchase additional fun music applications by going to **Music Apps**.

Transfer Music

Your phone is not just for talking. You can also listen to music from your favorite artists on your phone. Transfer your favorite tunes today.

- Make sure your music is in MP3, WMA, AAC, or AAC+ format
- 2. Insert a microSD card* (gold contacts facing down) into the port located at the top of the phone.
- Connect the phone to your PC using a USB data cable.*
- When the Portable Device screen appears on your PC, choose the Windows Media Player option.
- From within Windows Media Player, select the Sync tab. Songs will populate the left side of the screen. CF360 Music Sync Player should be the destination for the songs on the right side of the screen.
- Check/drag** the songs you want to transfer to the Sync List, and then click Start Sync.
- When finished, press the Right Soft Key for Cancel. Select Yes (1) to confirm this action, and then disconnect the USB data cable.

Warning! Do not disconnect phone while file transfer is in progress.



Play Music

Listen to music from your favorite artists right on your phone. To listen to music that you have transferred to your phone, follow these quick and easy steps.

- Insert a microSD card* (gold contacts facing down) containing music into the port located at the top of the phone.
- From standby mode and with the slide closed, press the Left Soft Key for Menu and then select AT&T Music (1).
- 3. Press the Key to select Music Player (1).
- 4. With **All Songs (1)** already highlighted, press the **Key**.
- 5. Highlight the song you want to play, and then press the **Key**.
- Press up or down on the Volume Keys to adjust the volume. Press left or right on the Navigation Keys to go to another song.
- Press the Left Soft Key for Minimize to access other phone functions without exiting the music player. To return to the music player, press the Key and select Music Player.

CV

CV brings your phone to life. Watch news, sports, weather, and entertainment clips while on the go.

- From standby mode and with the slide closed, press left on the Navigation Keys to access My Stuff.
- 2. Press the Key to select CV (1).
- Once connected, scroll with the Navigation Keys to highlight PLAY beside the video clip you want to watch and press the Key.

Personalize Your CV Home Page

- From the CV home page, use the Navigation Keys to highlight EDIT (next to My Favorites) and press the Key.
- 2. Select the content you would like added or deleted from your CV home page.

Note: Parental Controls available. See box insert for details. Access to CV requires a MEdia™ Max plan.



Camera/Video

Capture everything around you in vivid detail via the 1.3 megapixel camera and camcorder.


Taking a Picture

- 1. From standby mode and with the phone rotated horizontally, press and *hold* the Key.
- 2. Press the **Key** again to take the picture.
- 3. To send the photo to someone, use the **Navigation Keys** to highlight and then press the **Key**.

Recording a Video

- From standby mode and with the phone rotated horizontally, press and hold the Key on the right side of your phone.
- 2. Use the **Navigation Keys** to highlight in, and then press the **Key** to enter camcorder mode.
- 3. Press the **Key** to start/stop recording.

Note: To view your pictures and videos from standby mode, press left on the Navigation Keys to access My Stuff and then select Picture (4) or Video (5).



Video Share™

Share events the moment they happen. Video Share lets you stream live video directly to friends and family.

Making a Video Share Call

- From standby mode and with the slide open, dial the 10-digit number of another 3G Video Share capable device.*
- Once the call is answered, press the Left Soft Key for Video and then select Live (1).

Accepting a Video Share Call

- When receiving a Video Share call, the name or number of the person who wants to share video with you will appear on the screen.
- Press the Left Soft Key for Accept, and the Video Share session will begin automatically.

To end a Video Share session and continue with the phone call, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Stop**.

*Video Share is not available in all markets. Both parties must be in a 3G service area – a 3G icon must appear by the signal bars prior to a call being placed, and both parties must remain in the 3G coverage area for the duration of the Video Share session.




Mobile Email

Take your email with you with mobile email. You can access up to a dozen providers, including AT&T, AOL®, Yahoo!®, and Windows Live™ email accounts.

- From standby mode and with the slide open, press the Left Soft Key for Menu and then select Messaging (2).
- 2. Select Mobile Email (4).
- 3. Highlight your provider, and then press the Key.
- Accept the terms of use by pressing the Key for I Agree.
- Use the alphanumeric keypad to enter your screen name/ID or email, followed by your password. Then press the Left Soft Key for Sign In.
- 6. Highlight a message and press the Key to read it.
- Press the Key to delete the message, or press the Left Soft Key for additional options.

Text Messaging

When you need to communicate privately and quickly, use text messaging. You can send text messages to other wireless phones and email addresses.

- From standby mode and with the slide open, press up on the Navigation Keys to begin composing a text message.
- Use the alphanumeric keypad to enter your message. Press the **Left Soft Key** for **Insert** to include symbols, pictures, template text, and more.
- 3. Press the Key for Send To.
- Scroll with the Navigation Keys to highlight your recipient, and then press the Key for Select.
- Press the Left Soft Key for Send to send your message.



Instant Messaging

Chat in real time using your favorite instant messenger provider such as AIM®, Yahoo!, or Windows Live. Login on the go and stay connected with your wireless phone.

- From standby mode and with the slide open, press right on the Navigation Keys to access IM.
- 2. Use the **Navigation Keys** to highlight an IM community, and then press the Key.
- 3. Select Sign In (1).
- 4. Use the alphanumeric keypad to enter your screen name/email/ID, followed by your password.
- 5. Press the **Left Soft Key** for **Sign In**.
- 6. Highlight a contact currently online, and then press the **Key** for **Send IM**.
- 7. Type your message, and then press the **Key** again to send it.
- To end the conversation, press the Right Soft Key for Options, select End Conversation (5), and choose Yes (1).



MEdia™ Net

With MEdia Net, you can get the information that is important to you at a glance. Your local weather, your teams' scores, and your movie theaters are all just a few steps away.

- 1. From standby mode and with the slide closed, press the **Key** to access **MEdia Net**.
- 2. Highlight the content you want to view and press the **Key**.

Personalize Your MEdia Net Home Page

- From the MEdia Net home page, use the Navigation Keys to highlight EDIT (next to My Links) and press the Key.
- Select the content you would like added, moved, or deleted from the MEdia Net home page.

Or, Personalize Your Home Page from Your PC

- 1. Go to att.com/mymedianet from your PC.
- 2. Enter your mobile phone number and start choosing content to add to your home page.
- 3. Click **Update Now** to save your changes.




Multitasking

Multitask simultaneously with voice and data – browse the web, play games, send and receive messages, and listen to music. All at once.

- If you're involved in one task and want to launch another, press the Key and then press the Left Soft Key for Menu. You can then select another task.
- 2. To switch among multiple tasks, just press the to display the task icon bar at the bottom of the screen. Select a task icon and press the key.

Note: If you get a call while in another task (except playing music), you can accept the call, then return to the task while you're talking.





AT&T Navigator

AT&T Navigator, with GPS-enabled directions, is the fastest way to get where you are going – whether across town or across the country.

- From standby mode and with the slide open, press the Left Soft Key for Menu and then select AT&T GPS (6).
- The first time you log in, use the alphanumeric keypad to enter your phone number, first name, and last name. When you're finished, press the **Right Soft Key** for **GO**.
- 3. Press the **Right Soft Key** for **GO**.
- 4. Press the Key to select Drive To.
- 5. Select Address (3) and then Type It.
- Use the alphanumeric keypad to enter your destination. Press the **Right Soft Key** to toggle between letters and numbers.
- 7. Press the **Right Soft Key** for **GO**.

Access MEdia Mall


- From standby mode and with the slide closed, press the Left Soft Key for Menu and then press the Key to select MEdia Mall (5).
- Select Shop Tones (1), Shop Games (2), Shop Graphics (3), Shop Multimedia (4), Shop Applications (5), Shop Video (6), or MEdia Net (7) and press the Key.
- 3. Once connected, select a link to browse the mall.

Access Cool Games

- From standby mode and with the slide closed, press left on the Navigation Keys to access My Stuff.
- Scroll with the Navigation Keys to select Games (3) and press the Key.
- 3. Press the Key to select Shop Games.
