Getting to Know Your Phone



Transferring Music

1. Insert microSD card (gold contacts up).
2. The first time you transfer music, format the card. Press the **Left Soft Key** for **Menu** and select **Settings (9)**, **Memory (7)**, **External Memory (3)**, then press the **Right Soft Key** for **Format** and press **OK**.
3. With the phone on and in standby mode, connect it to the PC using a USB cable.*
4. Press the **Left Soft Key** for **Menu**, select **Settings (9)**, **PC Connection (5)**, then **USB Mass Storage (2)** to establish a connection to the PC.
5. The PC will recognize the phone as a **Removable Disk** under **My Computer**. Transfer your files by dragging and dropping them into the **LG_MEDIA > MUSIC** folder.
6. When done, disconnect the cable.



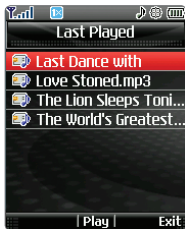

Playing Music

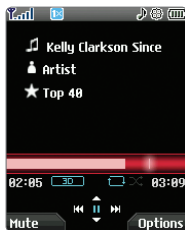
Playing Music with the Flip Open

1. Insert a microSD card* with music.
2. Press the **Music Key** on the phone's left side.
3. Scroll to the song you want and press **OK** to play/pause the music. Press **right** or **left** twice on the Navigation Key to go to the next or previous song.
4. Press **END** to exit the music player.



Playing Music with the Flip Closed

1. Insert a microSD card* with music.
2. With the flip closed, press and *hold* the **Music Key** to unlock the touch keys.
3. Tap **▶▶** or **◀◀** to go to the next or previous song on the list. Tap **▶||** to play/pause music.
4. To exit the music player, tap and *hold* **▶||** (unlock the touch keys if they're not activated).

Bluetooth® Pairing

1. Set your Bluetooth® accessory to pairing mode.*
2. Press **up** on the **Navigation Key** and select **Paired Devices (1)**.
3. Press the **Left Soft Key** to search. If Bluetooth® is set to off, you will be prompted to turn power on. Select **Yes (1)**, then **New Search (1)**.
4. The phone will search for the accessory. Once found, highlight it and press **OK**.
5. Enter the passcode (typically "0000" - 4 zeroes) and press **OK**.*
6. Press **OK** to connect with the device.

* Refer to the manual of your Bluetooth® accessory to activate pairing mode and for the passcode.

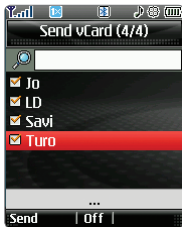

Sending Contacts via Bluetooth®

Sharing contact information is made easy. Send a vCard (electronic name card) to easily exchange names and numbers with another vCard-supported mobile phone or device via Bluetooth.®



1. Press **up** on the **Navigation Key** and select **Paired Devices (1)**.
2. Highlight the device you want, press the **Right Soft Key** for **Options**, then select **Send vCard (6)**.
3. If Bluetooth® is off, press **OK** to turn it on.
4. Press **OK** to select the contact(s) you want to send.
5. When finished, press the **Left Soft Key** to send.



Taking a Picture/Recording a Video

1. To activate camera mode, press . For video mode, press and *hold* .
2. Press **left** or **right** on the Navigation Key to adjust brightness and **up** or **down** for zoom.* Press the **Right Soft Key** to adjust other camera/video options.
3. Press  to take the picture or start/stop recording.
4. Press  to save or the **Left Soft Key** to send.



Note: To take self-portraits with the flip closed, press and *hold* the side  Key, then press either volume key to activate the viewfinder. Press  to take the picture.

* Camera setting of 1280 x 960 does not support zoom function.
